**Project Due Date: First Day of School, August 14, 2017**

**Materials:**

\*brown paper bag

\*crayons, paint, or colored pencils

\*notebook paper

\*glue or tape

**Procedures:**

**Procedure:** Read the book and create a "Book Report in a Bag".  
On the front side of the bag, you will use colored pencils, paint, or crayons to draw a picture representing the main idea or plot of the book. The summary should be written on notebook paper, first,

and then glued or taped to the back of the paper bag. The title of the book and the author should go on the sides of the bag. The bag can be decorated at your discretion, but the above components should be clearly distinguished. Objects of your child's choosing should be placed inside the bag that represents the story. Your child should be able to explain why they included the object.

Please be sure to adhere to all guidelines, as they will be used to assess an overall grade for the project. A scoring guideline, which the teacher will use to calculate your child's grade for the assignment is below. Please note this project will count as a Grammar and Reading project grade for the first quarter.
