Frequently Asked Questions



Why are we not having weekend monthly Mass anymore?

In a word—turnout. We found that aside from the parents of the class preparing the Mass, very few other SAS families or students come to represent our school. We understand that some families attend a different parish or go to Mass at a different time and some of our families are non-Catholics so the decision was made. However, we will have a weekend Mass during Catholic Schools Week and possibly during the Easter season.

Why do we have two choirs?

Mrs. LaBeau directs the school Mass choir and Mr. Comon directs the school Performance choir. The Performance choir performs for different occasions such as; Mother's Day, Christmas, and local events. Students sign up and audition for the Performance choir. It varies in age and grade levels.

Students in the school Mass choir sing at school Mass during the week or on weekends. This is on a rotation basis by class and students that stay after school on Wednesdays for practice.

Is bullying a problem and how do we address it, if so?

Fortunately, bullying is not a widespread problem at SAS. It would be untrue if I were to say it never happens, but in the event it does we deal with the problem quickly and swiftly. The first line of defense is the classroom teacher. If the problem persists, we get the counselor involved and the administration. We discuss the issue with all parties involved and strategize on ways to resolve the problem. Our counselor also does classroom lessons that address specific topics and bullying is among the topics discussed. In addition, she does one-to-one and group sessions if needed.

We take bullying very serious and it has no place in our school.
